



HOUSE BILL No. 6137

September 25, 1996, Introduced by Rep. McManus and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend Act No. 203 of the Public Acts of 1965, entitled
"Michigan law enforcement officers training council act of 1965," as amended, being sections 28.601 to 28.616 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 9a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 203 of the Public Acts of 1965, as
2 amended, being sections 28.601 to 28.616 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 9a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 9A. (1) IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION
5 9(1), THE COUNCIL SHALL PREPARE AND PUBLISH A MINIMUM COURSE OF
6 STUDY FOR THE TRAINING CURRICULUM FOR ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICERS.

7 (2) THE COURSE OF STUDY PREPARED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (1)
8 SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE SUBJECTS REQUIRED FOR A LAW ENFORCEMENT
9 OFFICER BUT THE SCOPE OF THE SUBJECTS SHALL BE LIMITED TO INCLUDE

1 ONLY THE INFORMATION THAT IS APPLICABLE TO THE DUTIES PERFORMED
2 BY AN ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER.

3 (3) AN OFFICER WHO HAS COMPLETED THE LIMITED COURSE OF STUDY
4 PREPARED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION SHALL ONLY PERFORM THE DUTIES
5 OF AN ANIMAL CONTROL OFFICER.
