



# HOUSE BILL No. 6142

September 25, 1996, Introduced by Reps. Profit, Perricone, Palamara, Brackenridge, Dobb, Gagliardi and Alley and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to amend section 203 of Act No. 327 of the Public Acts of 1945, entitled as amended

"Aeronautics code of the state of Michigan,"

being section 259.203 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Section 1. Section 203 of Act No. 327 of the Public Acts of 1945, being section 259.203 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 203. There is hereby imposed a privilege tax of 3 cents per gallon on all fuel sold or used in producing or generating power for propelling aircraft using the aeronautical facilities on the lands and waters of this state. ~~—, which~~ THE tax shall be paid to the secretary of state in the same manner and method and at the same time as ~~is now prescribed by law for the collection of~~ THE gasoline tax ~~now~~ THAT IS imposed on all

1 gasoline used in producing or generating power for propelling  
2 motor vehicles used upon the public highways of this state. A  
3 refund of 1-1/2 cents per gallon shall be made to airline opera-  
4 tors who show proof within 6 months after purchase that they are  
5 operating interstate on scheduled operations AND TO AIR  
6 CARRIERS. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "AIR CARRIERS" MEANS  
7 ENTITIES ENGAGED IN THE COMMERCIAL TRANSPORT FOR HIRE OF CARGO.
