

SENATE BILL No. 321

February 22, 1995, Introduced by Senator STEIL and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend sections 7 and 50 of Act No. 388 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended "Michigan campaign finance act," section 7 as amended and section 50 as added by Act No. 385 of the Public Acts of 1994, being sections 169.207 and 169.250 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 7 and 50 of Act No. 388 of the Public
- 2 Acts of 1976, section 7 as amended and section 50 as added by Act
- 3 No. 385 of the Public Acts of 1994, being sections 169.207 and
- 4 169.250 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Sec. 7. (1) "Filed" means the receipt by the appropriate
- 7 filing official of a statement or report required to be filed
- 8 under this act.

- (2) "Filer" means a person required to file a statement or
 report pursuant to this act.
- 3 (3) "Filing official" means the official designated pursuant
- 4 to this act to receive required statements and reports.
- 5 (4) "Fund raising event" means an event such as a dinner,
- 6 reception, testimonial, rally, auction, bingo, or similar affair
- 7 through which contributions are solicited or received by purchase
- 8 of a ticket, payment of an attendance fee, making a donation,
- 9 purchase of chances for prizes, or purchase of goods or
- 10 services.
- 11 (5) "Gift" means a payment, subscription, advance, forbear-
- 12 ance, rendering, or deposit of money, services, or anything of
- 13 value, unless consideration of equal or greater value is given in
- 14 exchange.
- 15 (6) "Honorarium" means a payment of money OR ANYTHING OF
- 16 VALUE to a person holding elective office as consideration for an
- 17 appearance, a speech, an article, or any activity related to or
- 18 associated with the performance of duties as an elected
- 19 official. An honorarium does not include any of the following:
- 20 (a) Reimbursement for the cost of transportation, accommoda-
- 21 tions, or meals for the person.
- (b) Wages, salaries, other employee compensation, and
- 23 expenses authorized to be paid by this state or a political sub-
- 24 division of this state to the person holding elective office.
- 25 (c) An award.
- 26 Sec. 50. A legislator AN ELECTED OR APPOINTED PUBLIC
- 27 OFFICIAL shall not accept an honorarium. A person who knowingly

- 1 violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a
- 2 fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or imprisonment for not more than
- 3 90 days, or both.
