



SENATE BILL No. 727

October 17, 1995, Introduced by Senators MC MANUS, GOUGEON, KOIVISTO, CISKY, NORTH, SCHUETTE and EMMONS and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Tourism.

A bill to amend Act No. 295 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

"State transportation preservation act of 1976,"

as amended, being sections 474.51 to 474.70 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 10a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 295 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
2 amended, being sections 474.51 to 474.70 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 10a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 10A. IF THE DEPARTMENT OFFERS FOR SALE TO THE CURRENT
5 CONTRACT OPERATORS ALL SEGMENTS OF STATE OWNED RAIL PROPERTY
6 UNDER THE CONDITIONS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 10, THE DEPARTMENT
7 SHALL NOT PARTITION ANY INDIVIDUAL SEGMENT OF THAT STATE OWNED
8 RAIL PROPERTY INTO MORE THAN 1 PARCEL.

1 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless

3 of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
