



# SENATE BILL No. 757

November 9, 1995, Introduced by Senators EMMONS, SHUGARS and BYRUM and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Senior Citizens.

A bill to amend section 8831 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts of 1961, entitled as amended "Revised judicature act of 1961," as added by Act No. 54 of the Public Acts of 1995, being section 600.8831 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1 Section 1. Section 8831 of Act No. 236 of the Public Acts  
2 of 1961, as added by Act No. 54 of the Public Acts of 1995, being  
3 section 600.8831 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 Sec. 8831. (1) ~~A~~ EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), A  
6 civil fine ~~which~~ THAT is ordered under section 8827 for a vio-  
7 lation of state statute shall be exclusively applied to the  
8 support of public libraries and county law libraries in the same

1 manner as is provided by law for penal fines assessed and  
2 collected for violation of a penal law of the state.

3 (2) Subsection (1) is intended to maintain a source of reve-  
4 nue for public libraries which previously received penal fines  
5 for misdemeanor violations of state statute ~~which~~ THAT are now  
6 designated state civil infractions.

7 (3) A CIVIL FINE THAT IS ORDERED UNDER SECTION 8827 FOR A  
8 VIOLATION OF A YOUTH TOBACCO PREVENTION ACT STATE CIVIL INFRAC-  
9 TION SHALL BE EXCLUSIVELY DISTRIBUTED TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL  
10 UNIT IN WHICH THE CIVIL INFRACTION OCCURRED. THIS SUBSECTION IS  
11 INTENDED TO ASSIST IN DEFRAYING THE COSTS INCURRED BY LOCAL GOV-  
12 ERNMENTAL UNITS TO ENFORCE THE YOUTH TOBACCO PREVENTION ACT.

13 Section 2. This act shall not take effect unless Senate  
14 Bill No. 730 of the 88th Legislature is enacted into law.
