

## SENATE BILL No. 874

February 21, 1996, Introduced by Senators HOFFMAN, DE GROW, CARL, V. SMITH, YOUNG, CHERRY, SCHWARZ, GEAKE, STEIL, SHUGARS, BENNETT and HART and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend chapter IV of Act No. 283 of the Public Acts of 1909, entitled as amended

"An act to revise, consolidate and add to the laws relating to the establishment, opening, discontinuing, vacating, closing, altering, improvement, maintenance and use of the public highways and private roads, the condemnation of property and gravel therefor; the building, repairing and preservation of bridges; setting and protecting shade trees, drainage, cutting weeds and brush within this state, and providing for the election or appointment and defining the powers, duties and compensation of state, county, township and district highway officials,"

as amended, being sections 224.1 to 224.32 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 5a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter IV of Act No. 283 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1909, as amended, being sections 224.1 to 224.32 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 5a to read as
- 4 follows:

1 CHAPTER IV

- 2 SEC. 5A. BY ORDINANCE, THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
- 3 A COUNTY MAY TRANSFER ALL THE POWERS AND DUTIES AND ALL THE
- 4 ASSETS AND LIABILITIES OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS
- 5 OF THE COUNTY TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND DISSOLVE
- 6 THE BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS.
