### **A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 4834 AS INTRODUCED 5-27-97**

House Bill 4834 would add a section to the Michigan Consumer Protection Act to make it a violation of the act to sell window blinds without including all of the following: 1) cleats, hardware, and instructions for installation that would allow the window blind cord to be secured; and, 2) a warning about the danger of accidental hanging or strangulation from window blind cords that are not secured. The requirements of the bill would apply to window blinds sold after the bill's effective date.
