A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5475 AS INTRODUCED 1-14-98

The bill would create the Human Cloning Research Prohibition Act to prohibit a person from using state funds to clone a human being or to conduct research on the cloning of human beings. "Clone" or "cloning" would be defined as "the asexual growing of a genetically identical human being from a single somatic cell of an individual."
