A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILL 5484 AS INTRODUCED 1-21-98

The bill would amend the Michigan Biologic Products Institute Transfer Act to transfer the Michigan Biologic Products Institute to the Department of Community Health as a Type I transfer effective February 17, 1998. The bill specifies that the institute would be an independent and autonomous entity, exercising powers and performing duties prescribed by the act independently of the principal executive departments, including personnel, budgeting, procurement, and management. In addition, the bill would transfer the Michigan Biologic Products Commission to the Department of Community Health, also effective February 17, 1998. The governor would appoint a director for the institute and the members of the commission. The bill specifies that the institute and the commission would have the powers, duties, and responsibilities prescribed in Executive Order 1995-25.

The bill would also make an appropriation of \$9 million for the remainder of fiscal year 1997-98. The appropriation would be from biologic product sales and other non-general fund revenues.
