Sec. 3109a. (1) An insurer providing personal protection insurance benefits shall offer, at appropriately reduced premium rates, deductibles and exclusions reasonably related to other health and accident coverage on the insured. The deductibles and sexclusions required to be offered by this section <u>shall be</u> ARE subject to prior approval by the commissioner and <u>shall</u> apply only to benefits payable to the person named in the policy, the spouse of the insured, and any relative of either domiciled in the same household.
