## HOUSE BILL NO. 4951

(As passed the House, October 9, 1997)

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 677 (MCL 168.677), as amended by 1996 PA 583.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 677. (1) -A EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBSEC-
- 2 TION (4), A precinct election inspector shall be a qualified and
- 3 registered elector of the county in which he or she serves OR, IN THE CASE OF A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT THAT LIES IN MORE THAN 1 COUNTY, IS A QUALIFIED AND REGISTERED ELECTOR OF THE LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT IN WHICH THE ELECTION IS BEING HELD, shall 4 have a good reputation, and shall have sufficient education and
- 5 clerical ability to perform the duties of the office. A person
- 6 shall not be appointed to a board of election inspectors unless
- 7 the person has filed an application with a city, township, or
- 8 village clerk in that county where the individual wishes to serve
- 9 as election inspector.

1 (2) The application shall be in his or her own handwriting
2 and shall contain the applicant's name, home address, ward and
3 precinct registration IF ANY, date of birth, length of residence
4 in the county, political party affiliation, education, employ5 ment, and other experience qualifications. The application shall
6 provide a certification that the applicant is not a member or a
7 known active advocate, as defined in section 674, of a political
8 party other than the one entered on the application. The form of
9 the application under this section shall be approved by the state
10 director of elections. The clerk shall maintain a file of appli11 cations filed under this section and make the applications avail12 able for public inspection at the clerk's office during normal
13 business hours.

(3) A person shall not be knowingly appointed or permitted to act as a precinct election inspector if the person or any member of his or her immediate family is a candidate for nomination or election to any office at the election or who has been convicted of a felony or election crime. A person shall not be permitted to act as an election inspector if he or she has failed to attend a school of instruction or failed to take an examination as provided in section 683. This section does not prohibit the candidate for or delegate to a political party convention from acting as an election inspector in a precinct other than the precinct in which he or she resides. An election shall not be invalidated merely because of the violation of the provisions of this section.

- 5 BERS OF THE BOARD REQUIRED TO BE APPOINTED UNDER SECTION 672 MUST
- 6 MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTIONS (1) TO (3). A PERSON WHO IS
- 7 APPOINTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MUST MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF
- 8 SUBSECTIONS (1) TO (3) OTHER THAN BEING A QUALIFIED AND REGIS-
- 9 TERED ELECTOR OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH HE OR SHE SERVES. A PERSON
- 10 WHO IS APPOINTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO BE DES-
- 11 IGNATED AS CHAIRPERSON OF THE BOARD UNDER SECTION 674.
- 12 (5) IF A PERSON SEEKING APPOINTMENT TO A BOARD OF ELECTION
- 13 INSPECTORS UNDER SUBSECTION (4) IS ATTENDING A K-12 SCHOOL AND IF
- 14 AN ELECTION FALLS ON A SCHOOL DAY, THE PERSON SHALL PROVIDE TO
- 15 THE CLERK, ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION FILED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (1)
- 16 AND (2), A WRITTEN DOCUMENT FROM HIS OR HER SCHOOL SPECIFICALLY
- 17 ACKNOWLEDGING THAT PERSON'S APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE
- 18 BOARD OF ELECTION INSPECTORS AND SPECIFICALLY EXCUSING THAT
- 19 PERSON FROM SCHOOL ON THE DATE OF SERVICE, IF SUCH APPOINTMENT IS
- **20** MADE.
