#### SUBSTITUTE FOR

#### HOUSE BILL NO. 5115

(As passed the House, December 3, 1997)

## A bill to amend 1867 PA 83, entitled

"An act to authorize and require county clerks to record the discharges of members of the armed forces of the United States; and to limit the disclosure of those discharge records,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 35.32).

# THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 2. (1) A county clerk shall enter <u>at large</u>, upon the
 record book <u>,</u> all <u>soldiers'</u>, <u>sailors'</u>, <u>marines'</u>, <u>nurses'</u>,
 DISCHARGES OF SOLDIERS, SAILORS, MARINES, NURSES, and members of
 women's <u>auxiliaries' discharges</u> AUXILIARIES that may be
 presented to the clerk for <u>record</u>, <u>and</u> RECORDING. THE COUNTY
 CLERK SHALL fully index <u>them</u>, <u>arranging</u> THE RECORDED INFORMA TION, AND ARRANGE the names of <u>the</u> soldiers, sailors, marines,
 nurses, and members of women's auxiliaries <u>,</u> alphabetically.
 The military service discharge <u>records</u> RECORD of a person

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shall be IS confidential and may be viewed or copied only by
 the PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2).

3 (2) EACH COUNTY CLERK MAY DO 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING:

4 (A) MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC INFORMATION IN A
5 RECORD DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) THAT IS NOT LESS THAN 70 YEARS
6 OLD AND THAT INCLUDES ONLY THE NAME, RANK, UNIT OF MILITARY SERV7 ICE, DATES OF MILITARY SERVICE, AND MEDALS AND AWARDS CONFERRED
8 UPON EACH INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFIED IN THAT RECORD.

9 (B) PURSUANT TO THE RECORDS MEDIA ACT, 1992 PA 116, MCL
10 24.401 TO 24.403, PROVIDE FOR THE VIEWING OR REPRODUCTION OF A
11 MILITARY SERVICE DISCHARGE RECORD OF A VETERAN BY ANY OF THE
12 FOLLOWING:

**13** (*i*) THE veteran. —, a

14 (*ii*) A person with the veteran's permission. -, or the
15 (*iii*) THE surviving heirs of -a THE veteran.

16 (*iv*) A veteran's service officer, -or the Michigan veterans 17 trust fund, or a person employed by the county department of 18 veterans' affairs who provides counseling for veterans, -shall be 19 given a copy of the service discharge record when IF access to 20 those records THAT RECORD is necessary to aid -a THE veteran, 21 or the surviving spouse or a dependent of -a THE veteran in 22 applying for benefits available to -a THE veteran.

23 (C) CHARGE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC FOR DISCHARGE RECORDS OF
24 VETERANS DISCHARGED 70 OR MORE YEARS AGO. HOWEVER, A PERSON
25 DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (B) SHALL NOT BE CHARGED FOR THE DIS26 CHARGE RECORDS OF THAT VETERAN.

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(3) Counties in which the clerk is not on a salary basis 1 2 shall compensate the clerk for this service THE RECORDING OF A **3** DISCHARGE UNDER SUBSECTION (1) at a rate of not less than 50 4 cents nor more than \$1.00, as directed by the county board of 5 commissioners, for each discharge recorded. The clerk shall make  ${\bf 6}$  a sworn statement at the end of every 3 months in each calendar 7 year as to the number of discharges recorded, and file the same 8 THAT STATEMENT with the county treasurer.

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(4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "70 YEARS OLD" MEANS 70 YEARS 9 10 FROM THE DATE OF THE FIRST DISCHARGE FROM MILITARY SERVICE OF THE 11 INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFIED IN THE RECORD DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1).

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
