

**SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR
HOUSE BILL NO. 5475**

A bill to prohibit the expenditure of state funds for the purpose of human cloning.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "the
2 human cloning funding prohibition act".

3 Sec. 2. As used in this act, "human cloning" means that
4 term as defined in section 16274 of the public health code, 1978
5 PA 368, MCL 333.16274.

6 Sec. 3. A person shall not use state funds to engage in or
7 attempt to engage in human cloning.

8 Sec. 4. Section 3 does not prohibit the use of state funds
9 for scientific research or cell-based therapies not specifically
10 prohibited by that section.

11 Sec. 5. This act does not give a person a private right of
12 action.

1 Sec. 6. A person who violates section 3 is subject to a
2 civil fine of \$10,000,000.00. A civil fine imposed under this
3 section shall be distributed in the same manner in which penal
4 fines are distributed in this state.

5 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless
6 all of the following bills of the 89th Legislature are enacted
7 into law:
