

# HOUSE BILL No. 4428

March 5, 1997, Introduced by Rep. Hood and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make appropriations for the family independence agency and

certain state purposes related to public welfare services for the fiscal

year ending September 30, 1998; to provide for the expenditure of the

appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of fees and other income received by the state agency.
