A bill to amend 1976 PA 453, entitled
"Elliott-Larsen civil rights act,"
(MCL 37.2101 to 37.2804) by adding section 701a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 701A. A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL OR OFFER TO SELL TO MEM-
2 BERS OF DIFFERENT RACES GOODS WITH IDENTICAL INGREDIENTS OR COM-
3 PONENTS OR GOODS WITH SPECIFIC, IDENTIFIABLE RACIAL CHARACTERIS-
4 TICS UNLESS THE PRICE FOR THE SALE OF THOSE GOODS IS IDENTICAL
5 FOR MEMBERS OF EACH RACE.
