A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled
"The social welfare act,"
(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 55d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 55D. IN DETERMINING THE ELIGIBILITY OF A RESIDENT
2 ALIEN FOR ANY MEANS-TESTED ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ADMINISTERED UNDER
3 THIS ACT, THE FAMILY INDEPENDENCE AGENCY SHALL INCLUDE AS THE
4 INCOME AND RESOURCES OF THE ALIEN BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:

5 (A) THE INCOME AND RESOURCES OF ANY PERSON WHO EXECUTED AN
6 AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT ON BEHALF OF THE ALIEN UNDER SECTION 213A OF
7 THE IMMIGRATION AND NATIONALITY ACT, 8 U.S.C. 1183a.

8 (B) THE INCOME AND RESOURCES OF THE SPOUSE, IF ANY, OF THE
9 PERSON WHO EXECUTED THE AFFIDAVIT DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION (A).
