THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the

- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act, "employer", "employee", and
- 4 "monitor" mean those terms as defined in the employee communica-
- 5 tions monitoring act.
- 6 Sec. 3. An employer shall not monitor the communications of
- 7 an employee unless the employer establishes a communication moni-
- 8 toring policy that is in writing, is disclosed to each employee
- 9 subject to monitoring, and does all of the following:
- 10 (a) Specifies the methods of monitoring that the employer
- 11 will exercise.

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(b) Specifies the communication media that will be subject
