

# HOUSE BILL No. 6105

September 17, 1998, Introduced by Reps. Walberg, Cropsey, McBryde, Kaza, Whyman, Hammerstrom, Horton, Lowe, McManus, Jansen, Geiger, Nye, Gernaat, London, Sanborn, Dalman, Birkholz, Green, Bodem, DeVuyst, Middaugh, Goschka and Perricone and referred to the Committee on Colleges and Universities.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 273, entitled

"An act to establish a Michigan educational opportunity grant program for resident qualified students enrolled in eligible public postsecondary schools; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 390.1403).

## **THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 3. (1) A recognized postsecondary school in this state  
2 is eligible to participate in the MEOG program under this act if  
3 the postsecondary school is a degree-granting public institution  
4 approved by the state board of education AND IS IN COMPLIANCE  
5 WITH THE TAXPAYER-FUNDED ABORTION PROHIBITION ACT.

6       (2) A grant shall not be made under this act to a student  
7 who is enrolled in a program of study leading to a degree in the-  
8 ology, divinity, or religious education.
