- 3 LEADER, AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES REGARDING
- 4 THE RESTORATION AND PRESERVATION OF THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING

- 21 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AS THEY RELATE TO THE ALLOCATION OF
- 22 SPACE IN THE CAPITOL BUILDING AND ON THE GROUNDS, INCLUDING LEG-
- 23 ISLATIVE OR STAFF OFFICES. ALL DECISIONS CONCERNING THE ALLOCA-
- 24 TION OF SPACE SHALL BE MADE ACCORDING TO THE RULES OR PRACTICES
- 25 OF THE RESPECTIVE BODIES.
- 26 (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "GROUNDS" MEANS THE PROPERTY
- 27 UPON WHICH THE STATE CAPITOL BUILDING IS SITUATED, BORDERED ON

- 1 THE NORTH BY OTTAWA STREET; ON THE EAST BY CAPITOL AVENUE; ON THE
- 2 SOUTH BY ALLEGAN STREET; AND ON THE WEST BY WALNUT STREET.

- 4 tive council act, 1986 PA 268, MCL 4.1701 and 4.1702, are
- 5 repealed.
