- 14 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1).
- 15 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IDENTIFY FROM THE DATABASE MAIN-
- 16 TAINED UNDER SECTION 8(1) ALL INDIVIDUALS WHO POTENTIALLY MEET
- 17 THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (1) OR (2) AND PROVIDE TO EACH OF
- 18 THOSE INDIVIDUALS AN OPPORTUNITY TO DEMONSTRATE THAT THE INDIVID-
- 19 UAL MAY AVAIL HIMSELF OR HERSELF OF A REMEDY DESCRIBED IN SUBSEC-
- **20** TIONS (1) AND (2).
