

SENATE BILL NO. 601

June 10, 1997, Introduced by Senator BYRUM and referred to the Committee on Health Policy and Senior Citizens.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending section 16181 (MCL 333.16181), as amended by 1993 PA 80.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 16181. A board may grant a nonrenewable, temporary
2 license to an applicant who has completed all requirements for
3 licensure except for examination or other required evaluation
4 procedure. A board shall not grant a temporary license to an
5 individual who has previously failed the examination or other
6 required evaluation procedure or whose license has been suspended
7 or revoked. A temporary license issued pursuant to this section
8 is valid for 18 months, EXCEPT A TEMPORARY LICENSE ISSUED TO A
9 LICENSED PRATICAL NURSE, A REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL NURSE, OR A
10 PHYSICAL THERAPIST, WHICH IS VALID FOR 12 MONTHS, but a board

1 shall automatically void the temporary license if the applicant
2 fails the examination or other required evaluation procedure.
3 The holder of a temporary license shall practice only under the
4 supervision of a licensee who holds a license, other than a
5 health profession subfield license, in the same health
6 profession. The holder of a temporary license shall not be
7 supervised by a licensee who holds a limited or temporary
8 license. The department shall promptly issue a temporary
9 license.
