- 5 NOT FRAUDULENTLY DISPOSE OF OR CONVERT TO HIS OR HER OWN USE, OR
- 6 TAKE OR SECRETE WITH THE INTENT TO DISPOSE OF OR CONVERT TO HIS
- 7 OR HER OWN USE WITHOUT THE APPOINTING COURT'S CONSENT, ANY MONEY
- 8 OR PROPERTY OF THE PERSON OR ESTATE FOR WHOM HE OR SHE IS A
- 9 GUARDIAN, CONSERVATOR, PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE, TRUSTEE, OR

10 FIDUCIARY.

- 1 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A
- 2 FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 YEARS OR A
- 3 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
