

SENATE BILL NO. 1122

May 7, 1998, Introduced by Senator GOUGEON and referred to the
Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 174a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 174A. (1) A GUARDIAN, CONSERVATOR, PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE,
2 TATIVE, TRUSTEE, OR OTHER FIDUCIARY WHO IS APPOINTED UNDER THE
3 MENTAL HEALTH CODE, 1974 PA 258, MCL 330.1001 TO 330.2106, OR THE
4 REVISED PROBATE CODE, 1978 PA 642, MCL 700.1 TO 700.993, SHALL
5 NOT FRAUDULENTLY DISPOSE OF OR CONVERT TO HIS OR HER OWN USE, OR
6 TAKE OR SECRETE WITH THE INTENT TO DISPOSE OF OR CONVERT TO HIS
7 OR HER OWN USE WITHOUT THE APPOINTING COURT'S CONSENT, ANY MONEY
8 OR PROPERTY OF THE PERSON OR ESTATE FOR WHOM HE OR SHE IS A
9 GUARDIAN, CONSERVATOR, PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE, TRUSTEE, OR
10 FIDUCIARY.

1 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1) IS GUILTY OF A
2 FELONY PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 10 YEARS OR A
3 FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000.00, OR BOTH.
