CONTENT

The bill would amend Part 401 (Wildlife Conservation) of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act to allow the taking of waterfowl or game birds with a single shot handgun loaded only with shot shell, except as otherwise provided by Federal law.

(Under the Act, the definition of "game" includes Hungarian partridge, pheasant, quail, ruffed grouse, sharp-tailed grouse, and wild turkey, as well as migratory game birds that are Federally protected.)
