6 (b) Ineligibility, because of federal law or regulation, for
7 further federal recognition in the person's current grade because
8 of age or length of service, and termination of the person's com9 mission or enlistment in the national guard of the United
10 States.

(c) Withdrawal of the person's federal recognition and

7 (2) A person who retires under subsection (1)(a) shall
8 receive pay of \$600.00 per year. A person who retires under sub9 section (1)(b), (c), or (d) shall receive pay of \$600.00 per year
10 upon reaching 55 years of age.

11 (3) Upon the death of a person who has completed not less 12 than 20 years of active service with the national guard or 13 defense force, or both, and who before his or her death met 1 of 14 the circumstances described in subsection (1)(b), (c), or (d), OR 15 WAS STILL IN ACTIVE SERVICE, a surviving spouse shall receive 16 \$300.00 per year until death.
