A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled

"The revised school code,"

by amending section 1104 (MCL 380.1104), as amended by 1995 PA 289.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1104. (1) If less than a majority of the offices of a
- 2 school district becomes BECOME vacant, the remaining members of
- 3 the board shall fill the vacancy immediately.
- 4 (2) If a vacancy is not filled within $\frac{20}{100}$ 30 days after it
- 5 occurs, the intermediate school board shall fill the vacancy by
- 6 appointment.
- 7 (3) If a majority of the offices are vacant at the same
- 8 time, the remaining member or members of the board shall
- 9 immediately call a special election of the school district to
- 10 fill the vacancies. If the election is not called by the

- 1 remaining member or members of the board within $\frac{20}{100}$ 30 days
- 2 after the happening of the vacancies OCCUR, or if all offices
