(1) If a library offers use of the internet or a computer, computer program, computer network, or computer system to the public, the governing body of that library may authorize or may require that the library restrict SHALL ADOPT AND REQUIRE ENFORCEMENT OF A POLICY THAT RESTRICTS access to minors by providing the use of the internet or a computer, computer program, computer network, or computer system in 1 OF the following manner WAYS:

(3) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A LIBRARY ESTABLISHED BY A COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT. A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, OR A PRIVATE LIBRARY OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.
