January 28, 1999, Introduced by Reps. Bishop, Mortimer, Pappageorge, Sanborn, Bovin, Richner, Kowall and Kukuk and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1962 PA 60, entitled

"An act to provide for the day parole of prisoners in county jails to permit them to be gainfully employed outside the jail or pursue other activities; to provide for the granting of reductions in terms of imprisonment and the regulation thereof; and to provide for the disposition of earnings from such employment,"

by amending sections 2 and 4 (MCL 801.252 and 801.254).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. The sheriff, or friend of the court in alimony or
