## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 215.  $\frac{\text{Any}}{\text{Any}}$  A person who falsely assumes or pretends to
- 2 be a sheriff, deputy sheriff, conservation officer, coroner, con-
- 3 stable, police officer, INVESTIGATOR OR INSPECTOR OF THE MICHIGAN
- 4 LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION, or member of the Michigan state
- 5 police, and shall take upon himself or herself to act as such, or
- 6 to require any person to aid and assist him or her in any matter
- 7 pertaining to the duty of a sheriff, deputy sheriff, conservation
- 8 officer, coroner, constable, police officer, INVESTIGATOR OR
- 9 INSPECTOR OF THE MICHIGAN LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION, or member of
- 10 the Michigan state police, or shall falsely take upon himself or

- 1 herself to act or officiate in any office or place of authority,
- 2 shall be IS guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment
- 3 for not more than 1 year, or by fine of not more than \$500.00.
