

## **HOUSE BILL No. 5135**

November 30, 1999, Introduced by Reps. Hart, DeWeese, Tabor, Van Woerkom and Lemmons and referred to the Committee on Family and Civil Law.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 815 (MCL 600.815), as amended by 1996 PA 374.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 815. The probate court shall not have terms of court.
- 2 The probate court shall be open at all reasonable times as fixed
- 3 by the probate judge or, in counties having more than 1 probate
- 4 judge, the chief judge. The probate court may hold evening and
- 5 weekend sessions. THE PROBATE COURT SHALL HOLD WEEKEND SESSIONS
- 6 WHENEVER NECESSARY IN A PROTECTIVE PROCEEDING OR GUARDIANSHIP
- 7 PROCEEDING UNDER CHAPTER 4 OF THE REVISED PROBATE CODE, 1978 PA
- **8** 642, MCL 700.401 TO 700.499, OR CHAPTER 5 OF THE ESTATES AND
- 9 PROTECTED INDIVIDUALS CODE, 1998 PA 386, MCL 700.1101 TO
