

HOUSE BILL No. 5324

February 8, 2000, Introduced by Reps. Vear, Rocca, Sheltrown, Richner, Van Woerkom, Bishop, Bovin and Birkholz and referred to the Committee on Energy and Technology.

A bill to amend 1991 PA 179, entitled "Michigan telecommunications act,"

by amending section 505 (MCL 484.2505), as added by 1998 PA 260.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 505. (1) An end user of a telecommunications provider
- 2 shall not be switched to another provider without the authoriza-
- 3 tion of the end user.
- 4 (2) The commission shall issue orders to ensure that an end
- 5 user of a telecommunications provider is not switched to another
- 6 provider without the end user's oral authorization, written
- 7 confirmation , confirmation through an independent third party,
- 8 or other verification procedures subject to commission approval,
- 9 confirming the end user's intent to make a switch and that the
- 10 end user has approved the specific details of the switch. The
- 11 order issued under this section shall require that all providers

- 1 comply with the regulations established by the federal
- 2 communications commission on verification procedures for the
- 3 switching of an end user's telecommunications provider.
- 4 (3) As used in this section and section 506:
- 5 (a) "End user" means the retail subscriber of a telecommuni-
- 6 cations service.
- 7 (b) "Telecommunications provider" or "provider" means a
- 8 person that provides 1 or more telecommunications services for
- 9 compensation. Telecommunications provider does not include a
- 10 provider of commercial mobile service as defined in section
- 11 332(d)(1) or OF part I of title III of the communications act
- 12 of 1934, chapter 652, 96 Stat. 1096, 47 U.S.C. 332.
