



HOUSE BILL No. 5764

May 10, 2000, Introduced by Rep. Callahan and referred to the Committee on Criminal Law and Corrections.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled
"The Michigan penal code,"
(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 136c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 136C. (1) A PERSON SHALL NOT TRANSFER OR ATTEMPT TO
2 TRANSFER THE LEGAL OR PHYSICAL CUSTODY OF AN INDIVIDUAL LESS THAN
3 18 YEARS OLD OR A VULNERABLE ADULT TO ANOTHER PERSON FOR MONEY OR
4 OTHER VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PERMITTED BY
5 LAW.

6 (2) A PERSON SHALL NOT ACQUIRE OR ATTEMPT TO ACQUIRE THE
7 LEGAL OR PHYSICAL CUSTODY OF AN INDIVIDUAL LESS THAN 18 YEARS OLD
8 OR A VULNERABLE ADULT FOR MONEY OR OTHER VALUABLE CONSIDERATION
9 FROM ANOTHER PERSON, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PERMITTED BY LAW.

1 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY
2 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 15 YEARS OR A FINE
3 OF NOT MORE THAN \$75,000.00, OR BOTH.

4 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "VULNERABLE ADULT" MEANS THAT
5 TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 145M.
