

SENATE BILL NO. 132

January 27, 1999, Introduced by Senator HART and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code, by amending section 803 (MCL 339.803), as amended by 1995 PA 217.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 803. (1) A person ~~who has~~ TO WHOM ANY OF THE FOLLOW-
2 ING CIRCUMSTANCES APPLY IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE
3 BOARD:

4 (A) HAS a material financial interest in any club, organiza-
5 tion, or corporation, the main object of which is the holding or
6 giving of boxing matches or exhibitions. ~~is not eligible for~~
7 ~~appointment to the board.~~

8 (B) HAS A DIRECT OR INDIRECT FINANCIAL INTEREST IN AN
9 INDIVIDUAL ENGAGED IN ANY BOXING OR SPARRING MATCHES OR
10 EXHIBITIONS. A MANAGER, PROMOTER, MATCHMAKER, TRAINER, OR BOXER

1 PARTICIPATING IN THE BOXING OR SPARRING MATCH OR EXHIBITION IS
2 CONSIDERED TO HAVE A FINANCIAL INTEREST IN THAT MATCH OR
3 EXHIBITION.

4 (C) PARTICIPATES, IN ANY MANNER, IN ANY BOXING OR SPARRING
5 MATCHES OR EXHIBITIONS OUTSIDE THIS STATE.

6 (2) A MEMBER OF THE BOARD WHO IS A MEMBER OF A BOXING CLUB
7 SHALL NOT VOTE ON ANY MATTER INVOLVING OR RELATED TO THAT BOXING
8 CLUB.

9 (3) A MEMBER OF THE BOARD SHALL NOT REPRESENT TO A PERSON
10 THAT HE OR SHE IS ACTING FOR OR REPRESENTING THE BOARD UNLESS HE
11 OR SHE HAS FIRST OBTAINED AUTHORITY FROM THE BOARD TO SO ACT OR
12 REPRESENT.

13 (4) A PERSON IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A LICENSE AS A PROMOTER OR
14 MATCHMAKER FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR AFTER CEASING TO BE A MEMBER OF
15 THE BOARD.
