## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 641A. (1) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2000 AND NOTWITHSTAND ING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, ALL ELECTIONS
HELD IN THIS STATE PURSUANT TO THIS ACT SHALL BE HELD ON 1 OF THE
FOLLOWING DATES:

5 (A) A WINTER ELECTION HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY FOLLOWING6 THE FIRST MONDAY IN FEBRUARY.

7 (B) A SPRING ELECTION HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY FOLLOWING8 THE FIRST MONDAY IN MAY.

9 (C) AN AUGUST PRIMARY HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY FOLLOWING10 THE FIRST MONDAY IN AUGUST.

1 (D) A GENERAL NOVEMBER ELECTION HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY 2 FOLLOWING THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER.

3 (2) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DIRECT AND SUPERVISE THE 4 CONSOLIDATION OF ALL ELECTIONS IN THIS STATE ON THE DATES SPECI-**5** FIED IN SUBSECTION (1).
