

**SENATE BILL NO. 200**

February 2, 1999, Introduced by Senators HAMMERSTROM, BULLARD, SIKKEMA, STILLE and SHUGARS and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled  
"Michigan election law,"  
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 641a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1        SEC. 641A. (1) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2000 AND NOTWITHSTAND-  
2        ING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, ALL ELECTIONS  
3        HELD IN THIS STATE PURSUANT TO THIS ACT SHALL BE HELD ON 1 OF THE  
4        FOLLOWING DATES:  
5        (A) A WINTER ELECTION HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY FOLLOWING  
6        THE FIRST MONDAY IN FEBRUARY.  
7        (B) A SPRING ELECTION HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY FOLLOWING  
8        THE FIRST MONDAY IN MAY.  
9        (C) AN AUGUST PRIMARY HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY FOLLOWING  
10       THE FIRST MONDAY IN AUGUST.

1 (D) A GENERAL NOVEMBER ELECTION HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY  
2 FOLLOWING THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER.

3 (2) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DIRECT AND SUPERVISE THE  
4 CONSOLIDATION OF ALL ELECTIONS IN THIS STATE ON THE DATES SPECI-  
5 FIED IN SUBSECTION (1).
