THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 9. ALL TELEPHONE SOLICITATIONS TO RESIDENTIAL TELE PHONE SUBSCRIBERS SHALL DO BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:

3 (A) WITHIN THE FIRST 25 SECONDS OF THE CALL AND AT THE CON4 CLUSION OF THE CALL, STATE THE NAME AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE
5 PERSON OR ORGANIZATION INITIATING THE CALL. THE TELEPHONE NUMBER
6 GIVEN MUST BE A TOLL-FREE NUMBER AND BE ANSWERED WHEN TELEPHONE
7 SOLICITATIONS ARE BEING MADE.

8 (B) THE PERSON ANSWERING THE TELEPHONE NUMBER PROVIDED UNDER
9 SUBDIVISION (A) SHALL BE ABLE TO PROVIDE INFORMATION CONCERNING
10 THE SOLICITATION CALL.
