Currently, schools operating before- and after-school care programs are required to comply with the requirements of the Child Care Licensing Act for these programs. HB 4617 would amend the Revised School Code to exempt such programs from these requirements and, instead, allow them to employ other quality and safety assurance measures.

Many of the new requirements in HB 4617 would require schools to maintain standards that already apply during the regular school day, such as doing criminal background checks on school staff, thereby allowing schools to avoid some of the additional costs of complying with current regulations. Also, an on-site child care center director would not be required under HB 4617, saving schools the costs of paying a director. To the extent that exempting these requirements reduces schools' cost of providing before- and after-school care programs, HB 4617 will reduce local costs in an indeterminate amount. This bill would have no state fiscal impact on the School Aid Fund.
