ADDENDUM TO SENATE FISCAL AGENCY ANALYSIS OF SB 813 DATED 11-27-01:

HOUSE COMMITTEE ACTION:

The members of the House Transportation Committee reported out the Senate-passed version of the bill.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The House Fiscal Agency concurs with the Senate Fiscal Agency that there would be no material impact on state or local costs or revenues. The House Fiscal Agency has prepared a chart to delineate the six kinds of contracts entered into by the Department of Transportation, in order to compare their current and proposed limits which would trigger review and authorization by the State Administrative Board. [The State Administrative Board was created by Public Act 2 of 1921 (MCL 17.1 et al). Its members include the governor, the lieutenant governor, the secretary of state, the state treasurer, the auditor general, the attorney general, the director of the Department of Transportation, and the superintendent of public instruction.]
