HOUSE BILL 4822 SUBSTITUTE H-1

SUMMARY

This bill amends the Michigan vehicle code to include expanding civil penalties to pending legislation HB 4822, to which this bill is tie-barred.

HB 4822 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to require a child between 40 and 80 pounds, who is four feet 9 inches or shorter, the child between the ages of 4 and 8 years, in a moving motor vehicle, to be seated in a manufacturer certified booster seat and secured by a seat belt.

HB 4821 includes a civil infraction on violators that shall be waived if, during the span of time between the violation and date of court appearance, the violator can prove the purchase of the proper restraint.
