SUMMARY

The bill would amend Public Act 142 of 2001 - the recently enacted Michigan Memorial Highway Act (MCL 250.1001 et seq.) - by adding Section 82 to designate portions of US-127 in Lenawee, Jackson, Ingham, and Clinton counties as the "Annie Oakley Memorial Pike". The bill would also repeal 43 House and Senate highway naming resolutions adopted between 1931 and 1995.

Section 2 of PA 142 indicates that the state transportation department shall only provide for the erection of suitable markers indicating the name of the highway "when sufficient private contributions are received to completely cover the cost of erecting and maintaining those markers". As a result, the bill has no state or local fiscal impact.
