A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 43532 (MCL 324.43532), as amended by 1996 PA 585.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 43532. (1) A person 17 years of age or older shall not
- 2 take aquatic species, except aquatic insects, in the waters over

- 5 in 1999, the fee for a resident restricted fishing license is

- 3 (2) The restricted fishing license entitles the licensee to
- 4 take aquatic species as prescribed by law other than trout or

- 6 (3) A PERSON UNDER 17 YEARS OF AGE MAY TAKE AQUATIC SPECIES
- 7 IN THE WATERS OVER WHICH THIS STATE HAS JURISDICTION, SUBJECT,
- 8 EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (4) AND (5), TO THE SAME

- 18 restricted fishing license for which that person is eligible.
