## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 509t. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law
- 2 to the contrary, a person who is a qualified elector in this
- 3 state and who registers to vote in a manner consistent with the
- 4 national voter registration act of 1993, is considered a regis-
- 5 tered voter under this act.
- **5** (2) A person who registers to vote in a jurisdiction in this
- 7 state by mail shall vote in person if that person has not previ-
- 8 ously voted in person in that jurisdiction. This subsection does
- 9 not apply to any of the following registered voters:
