- 3 EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL CLASSROOM IN GRADES 3 TO 12, BEFORE THE BEGIN-
- 4 NING OF EACH SCHOOL DAY, AN ORAL RECITATION OF THE FOLLOWING
- 5 EXCERPT FROM THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE: "WE HOLD THESE
- 6 TRUTHS TO BE SELF-EVIDENT, THAT ALL MEN ARE CREATED EQUAL, THAT
- 7 THEY ARE ENDOWED BY THEIR CREATOR WITH CERTAIN UNALIENABLE
- 8 RIGHTS, THAT AMONG THESE ARE LIFE, LIBERTY, AND THE PURSUIT OF
- 9 HAPPINESS. THAT TO SECURE THESE RIGHTS, GOVERNMENTS ARE
