"Income tax act of 1967,"

(MCL 206.1 to 206.532) by adding section 523.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 523. (1) FOR TAX YEARS THAT BEGIN AFTER DECEMBER 31,
- 2 2000, A CLAIMANT WHO HAS PAID A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT IMPOSED BY A
- 3 CITY, VILLAGE, OR TOWNSHIP FOR POLICE OR FIRE PROTECTION MAY
- 4 CLAIM A CREDIT, EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT PAID, AGAINST THE TAX DUE
- 5 UNDER THIS ACT FOR THE TAX YEAR. A CLAIMANT SHALL NOT CLAIM A
- 6 CREDIT FOR SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR POLICE OR FIRE PROTECTION
- 7 UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE CLAIMANT INCLUDED THE AMOUNTS PAID FOR
- 8 POLICE OR FIRE PROTECTION IN A CLAIM FOR A CREDIT UNDER SECTIONS
- 9 520 AND 522.
- 10 (2) A CLAIMANT SHALL CLAIM THE CREDIT ALLOWED UNDER THIS
- 11 SECTION ON THE SAME FORM THAT A CREDIT ALLOWED UNDER SECTIONS 520

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- 1 AND 522 IS FILED. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADJUST THE FORM
- 2 ACCORDINGLY.

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
