

HOUSE BILL No. 4575

April 17, 2001, Introduced by Reps. Vander Veen, Birkholz, Minore, Lockwood, DeWeese, LaSata, Mans, Scranton, Zelenko, Dennis, Kolb, Hansen, Jammick, Rison, Woodward, Neumann, Stallworth, Richner, DeVuyst and Thomas and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Urban Policy.

A bill to amend 1945 PA 281, entitled

"An act to provide for regional planning; the creation, organization, powers and duties of regional planning commissions; the provision of funds for the use of regional planning commissions; and the supervision of the activities of regional planning commissions under the provisions of this act,"

(MCL 125.11 to 125.25) by adding section 16.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 16. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS
2 ACT, A PLAN ADOPTED UNDER THIS ACT MAY BE AMENDED OR REPEALED
3 PURSUANT TO THIS ACT OR THE COORDINATED PLANNING ACT.

4 (2) A REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS
5 ACT SHALL NOT EXERCISE POWERS PROVIDED FOR BY THE COORDINATED
6 PLANNING ACT WITH RESPECT TO THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA UNDER THE JURIS-
7 DICTION OF A REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION ESTABLISHED UNDER THE
8 COORDINATED PLANNING ACT.

1 (3) A PLAN OR A SUCCESSIVE PART OF A PLAN ADOPTED UNDER THE
2 COORDINATED PLANNING ACT BY A REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION
3 SUPERSEDES A PLAN ADOPTED UNDER THIS ACT TO THE EXTENT THAT THE
4 ELEMENTS AND GEOGRAPHIC AREA OF THE PLAN ADOPTED UNDER THIS ACT
5 ARE COVERED BY THE ELEMENTS AND GEOGRAPHIC AREA OF THE PLAN OR
6 SUCCESSIVE PART OF THE PLAN ADOPTED UNDER THE COORDINATED PLAN-
7 NING ACT.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take
9 effect unless Senate Bill No. _____ or House Bill No. 4571
10 (request no. 00347'01 *) of the 91st Legislature is enacted into
11 law.
