

HOUSE BILL No. 6130

May 28, 2002, Introduced by Reps. Birkholz, Raczkowski, Kolb, Ruth Johnson, Rocca and Lemmons and referred to the Committee on Land Use and Environment.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending section 11514 (MCL 324.11514).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 11514. (1) A person shall not knowingly dispose of,
2 and an owner or operator of a landfill shall not knowingly permit
3 the disposal of, ~~medical waste~~ EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING in a
4 landfill:

5 (A) MEDICAL WASTE, unless that medical waste has been decon-
6 taminated or is not required to be decontaminated but is packaged
7 in the manner required under part 138 of the public health code,
8 ~~Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, being sections 333.13801~~
9 ~~to 333.13831 of the Michigan Compiled Laws~~ 1978 PA 368,
10 MCL 333.13801 TO 333.13831.

1 (B) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2006, A CATHODE RAY TUBE, INCLUDING
2 A TELEVISION OR COMPUTER MONITOR CONTAINING A CATHODE RAY TUBE.

3 (2) NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 1, 2003, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
4 CONVENE A TASK FORCE MADE UP OF REPRESENTATIVES OF MANUFACTURERS
5 OF ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS, RETAIL
6 BUSINESSES THAT HANDLE ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT, MEMBERS OF THE GEN-
7 ERAL PUBLIC, AND OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS. NOT LATER THAN JUNE
8 1, 2004, THIS TASK FORCE SHALL PROVIDE TO THE LEGISLATURE A
9 REPORT ON THE ADEQUACY OF REGULATORY PROGRAMS RELATED TO THE DIS-
10 POSAL OF ELECTRONIC WASTE AND IN PARTICULAR ELECTRONIC WASTE CON-
11 TAINING CATHODE RAY TUBES.
