- 6 OR MILK PRODUCTS MAY SELL OR OFFER FOR SALE A MINIMUM OF A
- 7 10% INTEREST PER FAMILY IN THE MILK-PRODUCING ANIMAL TO AN INDI-
- 8 VIDUAL OTHER THAN AN ON-FARM FAMILY MEMBER OF THE PRODUCER FOR
- 9 ONLY THE PERSONAL USE OF THE MILK OR MILK PRODUCTS.
