THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 372. (1) Except as otherwise provided by law or in

- 5 (b) Dispose of any property, real or personal, goods, chat-

- 1 (d) In a house, shop, or building owned or occupied by him
- 2 or her or under his or her control, knowingly permit the setting

- 4 (4) $\overline{(3)}$ A person violating subsection (1) is guilty of a
- 5 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2 years
- 6 or by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00.
