September 20, 2001, Introduced by Senators HART, BYRUM and SMITH and referred to the Committee on Human Resources and Labor.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 230, entitled "Stille-DeRossett-Hale single state construction code act," (MCL 125.1501 to 125.1531) by adding section 13e.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 13E. (1) IN PLACES OF PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION USING
- 2 BLEACHER SEATING, ALL BLEACHERS OR BLEACHER OPEN SPACES OVER 55
- 3 INCHES ABOVE GRADE OR THE FLOOR BELOW, AND ALL BLEACHER GUARD-
- 4 RAILS IF ANY PART OF THE GUARDRAIL IS OVER 30 INCHES ABOVE GRADE
- 5 OR THE FLOOR BELOW, SHALL CONFORM TO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING SAFETY
- 6 REQUIREMENTS:
- 7 (A) THE OPEN SPACE BETWEEN BLEACHER FOOTBOARDS, SEATS, AND
- 8 GUARDRAILS SHALL NOT EXCEED 4 INCHES, UNLESS APPROVED SAFETY NETS
- 9 ARE INSTALLED, EXCEPT THAT RETRACTABLE BLEACHERS ALREADY IN PLACE
- 10 AS OF JANUARY 1, 2002 MAY HAVE OPEN SPACES NOT EXCEEDING 9
- 11 INCHES.

- 1 (B) BLEACHERS SHALL HAVE VERTICAL PERIMETER GUARDRAILS WITH
- 2 NO MORE THAN 4-INCH RAIL SPACING BETWEEN VERTICAL RAILS OR OTHER
- 3 APPROVED GUARDRAILS THAT ADDRESS CLIMBABILITY AND ARE DESIGNED TO
- 4 PREVENT ACCIDENTS.
- 5 (C) THE DIRECTOR SHALL DETERMINE WHETHER THE SAFETY NETS AND
- 6 GUARDRAIL CLIMBABILITY MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.
- 7 ALL NEW BLEACHERS MANUFACTURED, INSTALLED, SOLD, OR DISTRIBUTED
- 8 AFTER JANUARY 1, 2002 SHALL COMPLY WITH THE CODE AND THIS
- 9 SECTION.
- 10 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO TEMPORARILY INSTALLED
- 11 BLEACHERS.
