2 (a) "Camping" means attendance at a residential, day, troop,

4 apart from their parents, guardians, or persons in loco parentis
5 for 5 or more days or parts of days in a 14-day period.

6 (b) "Immunizing agent" means a vaccine, antibody prepara7 tion, or other substance used to increase an individual's immu8 nity to a disease or infectious agent. IMMUNIZING AGENT DOES NOT
9 INCLUDE A VACCINE, ANTIBODY PREPARATION, OR OTHER SUBSTANCE USED
10 TO INCREASE AN INDIVIDUAL'S IMMUNITY TO A DISEASE OR INFECTIOUS
